NOVEMBER RECAP

- Capacity trading down across the board. The notable exception was an 80% rise in annualized equivalents over last year.
- The US started the winter heating season with the highest levels of natural gas storage since 2016, according to an EIA report on December 2nd *
- Injection season ends with withdrawals 20% lower than last year at this time *
- Natural gas demand for generation declined while residential and commercial use rose slightly as winter begins *
- Contiguous US marks its 19th warmest winter in the 129 year record **
