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APRIL RECAP

- M/m drop in deals and traded capacity were fairly normal for this seasonal shoulder month; however, we saw a sharp drop in annualized equivalents & long-term deals m/m and y/y.
- The drop in annualized equivalents was affected by the dip in long term deals as well as smaller deals overall, generally reflecting a more conservative outlook.
- April's decreased demand in the residential and commercial sector was offset by increased demand for generation as warming temps bring increased cooling needs.*
- Net injections into storage for April were estimated at a median of 268 Bcf.*
- The U.S. produced a record 103.2 bcfd of gas and consumed a record 90.4 bcfd of the fuel in 2024, according to U.S. EIA data.
